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LAMBOURNE PARISH COUNCIL

MINUTES 14th June 2023 at 7.45pm

An Ordinary Meeting of the members of Lambourne Parish Council was held On Wednesday 14th June 2023 in the Abridge Village Hall.

In attendance: Cllr D Hardy, Cllr L Shreeve, Cllr B Knowles, Cllr P Nash, Cllr D Moggridge & Cllr H Moore, Cllr C Karbaron, Cllr M Drewe

There were 13 members of the public and local PC Andy Cook (AC)

Meeting started at 7.45pm

The chair requested Cllr Nash take the minutes.

23.028 Apologies for Absence

23.029 Declaration of Interest

23.030 Public Consultation

AC Apologised for this being his first meeting this year due to various other commitments. He provided an update on crime figures within the area related mainly to motor vehicles and one aggravated burglary on London road along with a few other attempted burglaries. There were also a number of other reported crimes but overall crime was in line with other local areas and Lambourne did not appear to be an outlier. The level of crime also appeared to be in line with the previous 6 monthly average so no improvement or deterioration. AC said he would consider attending the next 'Come and Chat' group so members of the public can meet and raise concerns with him

Cllr Karbaron joined meeting at 19.46 Cllr M Drewe joined at 19.47

A member of public raised a concern related to bushes at 17 Poplars that is overgrown and the owner not cutting it back. Council will drop a note to the owners to request these are trimmed back. A further member made a similar complaint regarding London road. The council advised that Highways had only just restarted cutting back bushes and this was expected to improve significantly over the next few weeks and will keep an eye on how this proceeds.

A Member of the public representing the public attendees discussed the application related to Bliss Heights, 140 London road. They all objected to the recent license application believing it represented a public nuisance. Additionally it was highlighted that work was already underway without planning permission being approved and that green belt land was being destroyed by the current resident. There was a belief that toxic waste that had been requested to be removed by the council was instead just being spread across the meadow. Public were advised to write individually to EFDC under the four objections and raise any concerns over alleged spreading of waste to the enforcement



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department. It was suggested the council raise these concerns with the new District councillor Craig McCann and to invite him to the Parish meetings.

Lambourne Parish will write a letter of objection to the license application for Bliss Heights to EFDC

Cllr Moggridge raised a concern from a member of the public related to a neighbours tree that is overgrown and causing blockage. Cllr Moggridge to reach out to the member and advise them to raise this to Highways to be cut back

23.040 Highways Report

Cllr Shreeve raised a concern from a resident at Lambourne End whereby a walker could not get by on the public road due to overgrown bushes and so had to enter her property to be able to proceed. This occurred at New Road Lambourne End. Cllr Shreeve called EFDC and was referred to Highways and this has been escalated to them to cut back urgently.

Cllr Moore also highlighted issues raised by the public regarding the footpath from Abridge Chapel to the Chestnuts which was also overgrown

Cllr Nash will also talk to 8 London road to request they trim back the bushes next to the Malsters Arms Public House. Council to reassess at next meeting

23.041 Report of Responsible Officer

No report was provided but cheques were issued and signed

A discussion with Pinnacle is required to cease cutting the church gardens. The clerk on his return will write to Pinnacle and request a new quote and contract for just the Village Hall and the Parish land and remove the Church.

A&J lighting have provided a new contract to continue from August 1st. To be added to next month's agenda and voted on if the council wish to continue this maintenance contract.
