22.235 CCTV Camera at Playground Field

There was a discussion regards the three quotes and noted that there was a company looking on 26th January. It was decided that Acetech was the best option. The quotes were for slightly different work so price comparisons do not match exactly, but Acetech seemed the most comprehensive.

It was agreed to accept this quote on the proviso that the quote tomorrow is not a lot cheaper. If it is, this will then be discussed and decided on at the meeting on 15th February.

Cllr M Drewe will discuss this with the Trustees at the meeting on 26th January 2023.

22.236 Playground Update

There was a discussion around the quotation matrix put together by ClIr P Nash. Looking at the quotes for the Swing Set, at present it looks like Redlynch Leisure are the best value at £4,300.00 but this does not include removal of the Swing and the new surface that will be needed. Redlynch can quote for this.

The general feeling was that it will be best to go for metal as this normally gives a 20 year guarantee.

Cllr P Nash will speak Redlynch to get a quote for removal, flooring and 2 X Cradle Swings. He will also ask them to quote for the Multi Play unit etc.
